

CAMP CROATAN FOR KIDS!

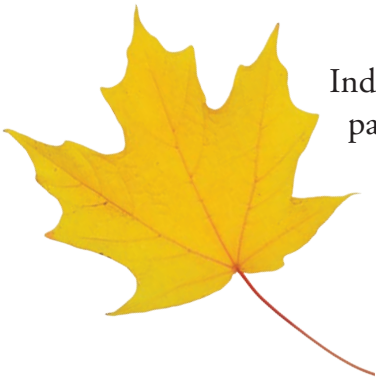
